

Undergraduate Studies

How to Apply - Entry Requirements

To be considered for undergraduate admission, applicants must submit the following:

/ A Completed Application Form (editable file).

/ A Certified and Translated in English copy of :

A **High School Leaving Certificate** with good performance and the **High School Diploma**, or the **International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma** or at least six **IB Subject Certificates** (including at least three at the higher level) with a minimum total of 30 points, or **A Levels** obtained locally.

/ Certified copy of one of the following Certificates in the English Language, acquired within three years before admission to the programme :

International English Language Testing System (IELTS Academic) with overall score of 6.0 or above, with at least 5.5 in each component.

Pearson – PTE Academic with overall score 55 or above, with no less than 51 in each component.

Cambridge Certificate in Advanced English (CAE) with overall score of 169 or above, with no less than 162 in each component.

Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE) with an overall score of 169 or above, with no less than 162 in each component.

Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) internet-based test (iBT) and special home edition, with overall score 79 or above, with a minimum of 17 in Listening, 18 in Reading, 20 in Speaking and 17 in Writing.

Michigan State University – Certificate of English Language Proficiency (MSU – CELP): CEFR C2

GCSE English Language with minimum Grade C / Grade 4.

iGCSE English Language with minimum Grade C.

Trinity ISE Level 3 with Pass in all components.

Duolingo with overall score 100, minimum 90 in all other components.

Examination for the Certificate of Proficiency in English (ECPE).

Michigan English Test (MET): overall score 230 and above with a minimum of 53 in each component.

Applicants who have completed their higher secondary education entirely through the medium of English Language are not required to hold an English language qualification.

If a candidate does not fulfill the English Language requirement and achieves a mark higher than 6.0 in the ATH/TECH placement test, they will be allowed to proceed with their enrollment on the condition that the required certificate will be submitted by the end of the first year of studies.
